What Is The Lamb Center?

The Lamb Center (TLC) is a daytime drop-in shelter for poor and homeless individuals in Fairfax, Virginia. Since opening its doors in 1992, thousands of guests have been welcomed and served. Currently, over 100 guests are served each day. The Lamb Center relies on the Lord's provision, and each day's operation is a miracle of service and spiritual nourishment and renewal.

Through the mighty efforts of TLC staff and volunteer churches and individuals, The Lamb Center provides our homeless guests with:

- Hot meals (breakfast and lunch) and fellowship,
- A place to shower,
- Hair cuts and a place to get mail and use the phone,
- Laundry facilities,
- Skilled staff to help provide recovery and employment counseling and case management.
- Spiritual support through Bible studies, chapel services, prayers, and counseling, and
- A place where someone knows each person's name and cares about each individual.

- 1,723 individuals served
- 106 guests (on average) each day
- 44,538 meals served
- 11,015 showers provided
- Over 10,000 group and individual counseling sessions
- 364 AA meetings
- Over 20,000 hours of volunteer support






Operating Income 2015 Total: \$1,169,041
